
Your league is now setup.

The next step is to begin adding Teams to your league. Once all of your teams have been added your members can complete the rest of the process on their own.



Add Team - Team Owners are a way to group multiple teams into one club. In RM this is merely a useful organizing tool. If you upgrade to RML's Paperless League Management System - Pro Edition this organization will become much more important.


For your first team you will have to use the "Use Team Name as Owner" option. After that you will be able to select that owner name to link other teams to.

Next, select the age of the team, enter the team name (which will also become the name of the new owner) and click the "Add New Team" button.
